

Pursuant to the general Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 of 27/04/2016.

Rights of clients and (prospective) entrepreneurs with respect to their personal data collected by DiES:

Information

The data collected from clients will be used for account processing and to inform them of the (entrepreneur) activities of DiES. The data collected from (prospective) entrepreneurs serve three purposes:

- entrepreneurial (application management and monitoring department activities)
- administrative (wages or fees management)
- informative (newsletters)

Clients and entrepreneurs agree with the collection of personal data for the above-mentioned purposes.

Right of access

Each client or entrepreneur is entitled to get confirmation of the data registered and the use of his/her data. We will reply in writing to any enquiry within 7 days of its receipt.

Right of rectification

Each client or entrepreneur is entitled to obtain rectification of any inaccurate data and completion of any incomplete data as soon as possible.

Right of erasure

Each client or entrepreneur is entitled to have his/her data erased in case of withdrawal of processing consent, objection to such processing, if the data are no longer required for processing purposes, if they were unlawfully processed or if their erasure is required by law.

Right to restriction of processing

Each client or entrepreneur objecting in writing is entitled to restricted processing of his/her data, if he/she challenges the accuracy of the data, if he/she notes unlawful processing or requires them to establish, exercise or defend his/her rights in court.

Right to data portability

If processing is based on consent or a contract and carried out by means of automated processes, the client or entrepreneur concerned is entitled to obtain the data in a structured format commonly used and to transmit them to another controller without the initial controller's interfering.

Right of objection

The client or entrepreneur has the right to object to the processing of his/her data at any time if required to carry out a task of public interest or for purposes of the controller's legitimate interest. The client or entrepreneur may also object to processing for prospection purposes.
